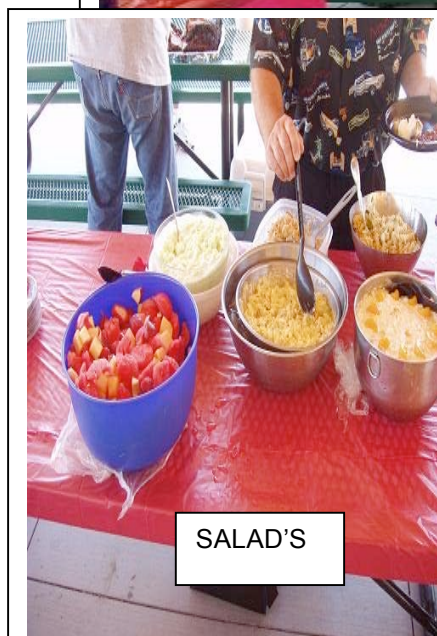
Tragedy in the Pontiac Family

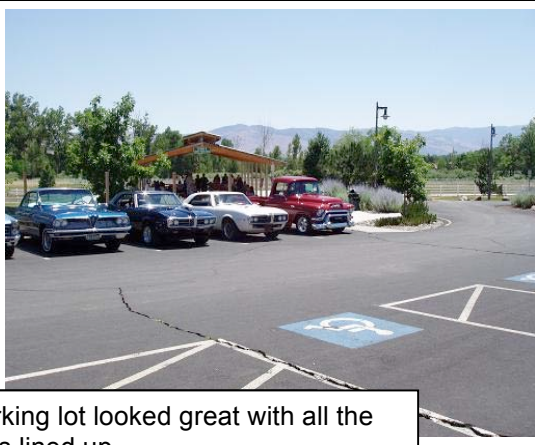
